Conscious that I have failed in many respects to sustain the honor, which belongs to a most honorable profession, & ^may have failed to carry the science to the highest pitch of perfection, I have a pride in declaring that in all things I have intended to ^do right_ & devoid as I am of a Liberal education, few, have been more fortunate in money making & had I attended to the pitiful calculations of "pounds, shillings, & pence," I might at this day be called, a man of fortune" But in the early years of my professional career, thee were a number of hangers on, nicknamed friends who were at all times ready to pledge me in a a glass of generous madeira Delivered by this phantom, I neglected to realize the profit of 30 years toil_during which time, I re ceived at least \$130'000
